No Damage

Once the home or building is complete, no holes will have to be drilled in your new flooring or walls for your internet or security system installation.

Avoiding Other Lines

By pre-wiring your home or business, you can avoid the hassle of damaging existing lines or interfering with other wiring throughout the structure.

Hard-Wiring Devices

With a pre-wired home or business, you can conveniently hard-wire more devices which results in a stronger internet connection.

Steps to Getting Your New-Build Pre-Wired



Pre-Wiring must be done before the sheetrock is installed

Step 1:

Contact FTC at least three weeks before the sheetrock installation date. This allows enough time to ensure FTC can add the pre-wire installation on the schedule

Step 2:

Once you have spoken with a customer service representative, they will get your information to the installation department and they will contact you with a date on when they will be there to complete the pre-wire.

If you are a new FTC customer, you will be required to fill out new service paperwork. This can be done via email or at our business office in Rainsville.

Step 3:

FTC HIGHLY recommends that you allow us to come out when the electrical trench is dug through the yard. This will allow us to place our fiber in the trench while it is still open and we will not have to dig up your yard again.

For homes or structures that are built on a concrete slab

Please place conduit from the nail-in-box up into the attic and on the exterior wall beside the power meter. If you have any questions concerning this, please contact the FTC business office at 256-638-2144.

What are the costs associated with having your home pre-wired?



There is a \$75 trip charge for the fiber pre-wire. Each additional wire is \$90; If you want multiple TVs or other devices hard-wired, you will need one wire per device



For a security system pre-wire, FTC will send out a salesperson that will provide you with a quote for the pre-wire costs.
